



Artist Statement Philipp Wisser // Just A Glimpse

In addition to personal moments, it is also about one of the central questions in artistic creation: How do I give expression to a moment? That cannot be summed up in words. On the one hand, an adequate answer should be simple and direct, on the other hand, there is a great risk of falling into old phrases like "Live the moment!".

It is precisely these opposites that fascinates me enormously. Aren't the most insignificant things often wonderful at their core? Have we perhaps even forgotten how to see miracles and learned to make things more complicated than they should be?

With these questions at heart, music as an art form gains existential importance. It is not only (inevitably and always) a form of expression of a moment, but also becomes an instrument itself. An instrument that helps us to understand ourselves better.

At least this is the intention behind my debut work. To what extent I succeed with the compositions and the band in interaction, the listener can and should decide for him or herself. Ultimately, it's more about an attitude than a specific result.
